Contest Rules:

1. Entry must be an original, hand drawn artwork – computer generation will NOT be accepted.
2. Poster entry must be from 8.5” x 11” to 14” x 18” in size.
3. The poster must be related to the contest theme in some way. The theme "Trees For Bees" must be wrote on the poster, and spelled correctly.
4. Entry must be signed on the back of the poster with the student’s name, and the entry/permission form signed by their parents must be attached to the poster.
5. Teachers: please send **ONLY ONE** poster from each participating class. Choose whatever method you like for determining the top entry (classroom/school contest, art fair display, popularity vote, etc.)
* If you are participating as an individual, home school, or through a library, this rule does not apply.
6. Entries must be mailed flat...not rolled, folded, framed, or laminated.
7. Posters WILL NOT be automatically returned. If you would like your poster back, please send a self-addressed, pre-stamped envelope large enough to hold your poster along with your entry and we will mail it back to you!
